Role entails assisting head coach with day-to-day volleyball operations including practice plans, team organizational functions, monitoring academic performance of athletes, collecting and analyzing match statistics, and scouting / film break down to assist with match preparation and competition. I implement volleyball recruitment plans, order apparel, organize official and unofficial visits, and arrange team travel requirements for off-campus trips (airline reservations, hotels, vehicle rentals, and team meals). I promote a positive team culture to ensure success on and off the court, and maintain high priority on student success and 100% graduation rate, 1000 APR for the past 4 seasons.

FAMU finished first in the MEAC Southern Division three years and Runner-Up at the MEAC Conference Championships in 2016 and 2017. In 2018, FAMU earned a bid to the National Invitational Volleyball Championships (NIVC). 2020 season was cancelled due to COVID. 2021 was a break out season for our staff, we finished 25W-7L (4th best record in school history), we won the SWAC Championship over Jackson State and made the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 13 years! We won the Auburn Invitational with 3 victories to include a 3W-2L upset over host Auburn we also defeated Big South Champions Campbell University. 2021 FAMU had three SWAC "Player of the Year Selections" Overall MVP, Setter, and Libero.

<u>Junior Olympic Volleyball Coach / PSVA Satellite Director</u>

USA CAP Level 1 coaching certification, competed at venues across the south east, organized and directed several volleyball tournaments (including accommodations for visiting teams), scheduled court assignments, and organized hospitality room set up. I have lead teams to three National Championship Events, and am currently an Elite level coach at Prostyle VB Academy and Satellite Director, I organize and direct 40 to 50 teams/coaches in 20 to 30 towns across the Florida Panhandle.

I have coached 38 seasons - which includes 22 seasons of basketball (boys and girls at all age levels) and 20 seasons of College, High School & Junior Olympic Volleyball. I guided the Mosley basketball team to five Florida Regional basketball appearances and 2 district titles, and lead the volleyball team to four Florida Regional "Sweet 16" appearances and a district title.

The club averages 50-70 players, 6-8 teams and 10-12 coaches per year. Club Fusion was the premiere volleyball club in Bay County with six successful seasons and an impressive amount of high rated tournament finishes. Responsibilities Include: Organizing a seasonal two day volleyball event in multiple locations for 60 plus teams. Training and supervising coaching staff, evaluating volleyball skills and creating teams, creating team schedules, payroll, hotel accommodations, acquiring event sponsorship, organizing officials, marketing players to colleges, creating a vision for program volleyball training, updated Advanced Event System (AES), organizing monthly training schedule, marketing and advertising volleyball to the Florida Panhandle.
